It's feels like winter has arrived out of the blue. As I write this in mid-November, snow has just begun to cover the ground. The temperatures, though not yet frigid, have turned cold. It is clear: winter is upon us. Already, only three days in, the fullness of winter is upon us. The dark days feel dreary. The sun glimmers off the white snow. Slick roads and sidewalks slow us down. The change of seasons reminds me that our world is at once both beautiful and broken.

As the season changes around us, we enter into the church season of Advent. Advent comes from the Latin word for "visit, arrival, or coming." During the season of Advent we are invited to keep our eyes, ears, and hearts open to the ways that Jesus enters into our world again and again. As church community, we will remember that "Out of the Blue" Jesus comes into our midst. Jesus surprises us with hope, joy, justice, and opportunities of all sorts. Because of Jesus, we can go on breathing, releasing, receiving, and rejoicing.

Each year, this holiday season comes with many memories and expectations. We recall experiences from the past, some of which fill us with delight and some of which leave our hearts aching again. We plan and prepare. We can feel overwhelmed, underwhelmed, and maybe sometimes just whelmed.

My prayer for you, Faith Lutheran Church, is that in the midst of it all, that out of the blue Jesus might meet you. Maybe Jesus will inspire you to light a candle and rest in God's love. Maybe Jesus will stir you to slow down, look out the window, see snow upon snow and remember God's grace upon grace. Maybe Jesus will nudge you to come to Advent Lunch & Prayer on Wednesdays at church or watch the Mid-Week Advent Reflection shared on our church Facebook and YouTube pages. Maybe Jesus will lead you to give or receive in such a way that leaves you stunned. Seemingly out of the blue, Jesus came into this world. We wait and wonder, and trust that out of the blue, Jesus comes again.

Pumpkin Pie Dump Cake

Ingredients:

1 can (15 oz) pumpkin puree (not pumpkin pie mix)
1 can (12 oz) evaporated milk
3 large eggs
1 cup sugar
1 tsp ground cinnamon
1 box Spice Cake Mix
1 cup butter, melted

Directions:

Preheat oven to 350 degrees

Spray a 9 x 13 baking dish with nonstick cooking spray.

In a medium bowl, combine pumpkin puree, evaporated milk, eggs, sugar and cinnamon until well combined. It will be very liquid-y. Pour this pumpkin mixture into the baking dish.

Sprinkle dry cake mix on top of pumpkin mixture.

Now take melted butter and drizzle all over the top.

Bake for about 55-60 minutes.

It might still be just a bit jiggly in the middle when done. It will continue to set up as it cools. Let it cool for at least 30 minutes before serving.

Be sure to refrigerate any leftovers.

Dollop each serving with a bit of whipped cream.

Morris Area Community Education & Recreation

55+ Refresher Course: In-person

Instructor: Mary Holmberg

Improve your driving skills, and if you're 55 or older, get a discount on your personal auto insurance. This Defensive Driving Course, developed by the National Safety Council, teaches basic crash prevention techniques, and has a proven record of reducing traffic violations and incidents. This course will be facilitated by Instructor Mary Holmberg. The class consists of lecture, films, and discussions. There is no behind-the-wheel driving and there are no tests.

According to Minnesota state law, people age 55 and older who complete a state-approved defensive driving course are eligible to receive a 10 percent, three-year discount on auto insurance. If you have successfully completed a state-approved eight-hour defensive driving course you are eligible to take this 4-hour defensive driving course to renew your insurance certificate. After you complete this 4-hour course, you will receive a certificate of completion to give to your insurance company.

To ensure the proper documentation is filed with the State of Minnesota, participants must register PRIOR to December 10.
