We are going on a mission trip!! I want to share with you about an exciting opportunity that Fusion is doing this summer. 17 youth and adults are going on a mission trip to the Blue Ridge Mountains in Rutherford County, NC July 17th—23rd with an organization called YouthWorks! Here are the youth and adults who are signed up to go! Youth: Piper Swanson, Sarah Dougherty, Micah Ulrich, Jason Christians, Isaac Just, David Black Jr., Truett Richards, Evan Oberg, Lilia Asmus, Hannah Schneider, Bryn Lonergan, Wesley Richards & Jayden Marquart. Adults: Heather & David Black, Pastor Chris Richards & Amy Dougherty.

On this trip our group will experience the great beauty of both people and nature in the scenic small towns that surround the Blue Ridge Mountains of North Carolina. By participating in children's ministry, completing work projects and supporting local ministries, we'll make connections with the people of the area while addressing some significant needs. We may serve at a food pantry, clothing distribution center, soup kitchen, or by assisting with youth programming at a local YMCA. We may also serve through community beautification projects, gardening, painting, yard work or assisting with simple work projects and minor home repair projects. Youth-Works has served the Blue Ridge community since 2006 but recently moved the site to Spindale in Rutherford County, NC in summer 2021.

Would you be willing to partner with us by praying? Prayer is so essential to the success of this trip. I would love it if you would partner with us by being in prayer for this mission trip experience! Specifically, in these areas:

Pray for the 17 of us who are going – that we would be open to learning from the community we're visiting and that we grow closer as a team and closer to Jesus.

Pray for the YouthWorks staff who are living in the Blue Ridge Mountains all summer and will be leading us during the trip. Pray for the community members who we meet – that we could love and honor them well.

Would you also consider partnering with us financially? The cost of this trip is \$800. Like a "real" missionary, we have challenged the youth to raise their own support to help fund this trip.
