# HAVE WE STRETCHED YET?

One of the rules that we have at our home is that there is "no slime allowed." I'm convinced, no matter how careful someone might be with slime, once it's stretched out, there will be a mess. The last thing I want stuck between our couch cushions or pressed onto the carpet is ooey, gooey, stretchy slime! Sometimes stretching makes a mess.

Back in January, here at Faith Lutheran folks were given an opportunity to pick a "star word" in worship. These words were meant to serve as a guide and inspiration for our lives. At random, the word "**STRETCH**" was chosen as a word for our congregation. As I have gotten to know you and you have gotten to know me, it seems a fitting word for our year.

I celebrate the ways I have seen Faith Lutheran STRETCH already in 2023:

- •You've *STRETCHED* in how we deal with trash by adding organics recycling. We are slowly learning: Food waste and some paper products (including paper towels) go in the organics recycling. Paper, bottles, and boxes go in regular recycling. All other waste (or when we aren't sure) goes in the garbage. This may feel little, but it's one thing we can do together to care for God's good creation.
- •You have *STRETCHED* yourself by learning a few new hymns! They maybe weren't perfect the first time, but they've gotten better. Way to go.
- •You've STRETCHED yourself by passing the offering plates again.
- •You have *STRETCHED* in your giving, supporting many special projects. For example, during Christmas in July \$1,807.47 was collected. This will be used for service projects nearby and far away. Wow! Thanks
- •You have continued to *STRETCH* in supporting Fusion Youth Ministries, as an extension of our congregation's mission. Fusion is a vibrant, difference making, ecumenical ministry. It is bigger than any one congregation can do alone. This fall, 60+ kids will gather on Wednesday nights Element. They will grow in relationship with Jesus and each other. The weekly senior high gatherings will also be transitioning into meeting on Wednesday nights this year. Please continue to pray for this ministry.
- •You are *STRETCHING* in our understanding of what it means to "Live Out Our Faith" during our sermon series this fall. Thanks for your playfulness and participation.


