As your pastor this fall, I have had the privilege of connecting with some of our partners in ministry from places all over the world.

Michael and Carmen are from Bethlehem and Jerusalem. They work with artists in Bethlehem who create beautiful carvings out of olivewood. The artists are Palestinian Christians, and rely on income from the carving to provide for their families. Michael and Carmen urge us to continue to pray for peace for all people. My conversations with them have reminded me about how complicated the relationship between Israel and Palestine is. The news we get through our media outlets is only a glimpse at the many stories that actually exist. (We'll have the olivewood out on Sunday, November 19, so you'll have a chance to take a look at it.)

Pastor Celiwe is from South Africa. She traveled with Southwest Minnesota along with other church leaders from the Evangelical Lutheran Church in South Africa, which is our companion or partner synod. Pastor Celiwe shared about the work that she is doing to revive a seminary. Buildings that had been abandoned are now being restored. Students are returning to the campus to be trained for church leadership. While in the United States, Pastor Celiwe also spent time at Luther Seminary, which will inspire her in her efforts at home. In my conversations with Pastor Celiwe, I was reminded that even when it seems like a story is over, that the Holy Spirit is often given space to work and bring new possibilities.

Mary and Rodney lead a mission called FARM Haiti. You may recall that they presented about this ministry earlier in the year in worship. They were back again this fall and shared more about the ministry. One of the ministries supported through FARM Haiti is a tree planting. One source reports that only 1% of Haiti's original primary forest remains, due to humans dependence on trees. They grow and distribute seedlings to allow for new tree growth. Mary and Rodney remind me of what it looks like to boldly live in faith, trusting that the impact we make on a few lives can have ripple effects to many.

On Sunday, November 5th, we will celebrate All Saint's Sunday. We remember that we are connected with Christians from all sorts of time and all sorts of places. In John, Chapter 17, Jesus prays, "My prayer is...that all of them may be one, Father, just as you are in me and I am in you. May they also be in us so that the world may believe that you have sent me."

It's easy to go about our life, focusing only on what is right in front of us. Yet, Jesus connects us one to another. Jesus loves you, and Jesus loves folks all over world! In Christ,



Fusion Student Ministry's Purpose And How we are accomplishing that purpose:

Engage – There is a need for this ministry to the youth and families of this community. The four churches involved have a little over 150 kids to pull from. Our goal is to engage youth both inside and outside the church walls!

In September – October Element: 56 students; Sr. High: 25 students; Parent Small Group: 5-8; Social Media & Website: Great way to engage the community and communicate what we are up to; Leadership: 17 adult volunteers & pastors & Student leadership: 4 students; Element Parent Meeting: 75 Parents/caregivers (roughly)

Connect – Having a sense of connection to others is so important at all ages, but especially during the 6th-12th ages. We have a goal to help youth connect to other youth as well as to positive adults. We want to provide a safe environment for them to feel welcome, wanted and known. Love them where they are. Love is messy and the people we love are not perfect. Teenagers are certainly not perfect and in the messiness of life are looking for positive love and acceptance.

In small Group time and small group get togethers they are connected together, making friendships in a safe space and are connected to healthy adult leaders; Sr. High Lock-In & various fun activities helps to connect them through shared fun memories; & the Church without Walls pork chop lunch connected the youth and families to the church community!

Teach – Our goal is to teach youth to answer the question, "What do you believe about God and what does your life look like because of it?" This will be done through fun and creative teaching, experiences, connecting in small groups and letting them ask the hard questions.

We are teaching the Fruit of the Spirit Series in Element and Renew your Heart, Soul, Mind & Strength Series in Sr. High Fusion. The kids open their bibles, highlight in them, memorize bible verses and learn how to apply the truth of scripture to their daily life.

Send – Our goal is to send them out into the world with knowledge about God and how He relates to the world. Send them out to adventure and service. We want to make lifelong Christians who can love fiercely and respect others. Challenge them to live out their faith in all aspects of their life: at school, home, church, work and with friends and family.

We send our students and adults out into the world in so many ways. We sent out over 80 youth and adults on a prayer walk to pray for our community, churches, businesses & law enforcement (etc). We encourage our adult leadership to reach out to their students outside of Fusion. On Sat, Oct 14th a group of students and adults helped a family in Benson move into their home. And we are training future leaders: Piper Swanson, who is our Sr High Fusion Intern wants to be a youth pastor in the future and is leading in the Sr. High Fusion area! And students in student Leadership in Sr. High Fusion are stepping up to the plate to help lead and plan!

SCOUTS—First and foremost, we would like to extend a huge thank you to Faith Lutheran Church for allowing our charter to transfer to our new home with you. We are very excited to share adventure, team building, and life skills and experiences with the congregation and hopefully families around the community as well. We look forward to building foundations for the future in our children today – that's what scouting is all about. Did you know GIRLS AND BOYS can join?! We plan to meet the first (1st) and third (3rd) Sunday of each month in the fellowship hall at 3 p.m. Anyone and everyone is welcome to come for a meeting and see what we are all about. With colder weather imminent, getting out of the house and seeing other people may be just what the doctor ordered this winter season, and we would love to have you join us! The pack is also in need of a Committee Chairman – prayerfully consider contacting us for more information if you would like to know more about what this is about.
